After retiring from the Air Force, Charlie and wife, Melissa, along with their children Michele and Justin, moved to Grandview in 1979.

Charlie retired for a second time from True Value Distribution Center and began working as a volunteer at the Grandview Assistance Program (GAP) in 2002, where his 20 hours per week are filled with numerous jobs, including running the food pantry for the last 18 years, training hundreds of volunteers, in addition to delivering food to GAP clients, picking up weekly food donations at a local restaurant, picking up other donations such as school supplies, clothing donations and Christmas items for local children, making general repairs to the GAP's building, grounds and office and helping to shop for groceries and picking up donated items at Harvesters, etc.

Charlie has volunteered at other numerous charitable, business and recycling centers, such as the Grandview Animal Hospital, helping with the City's Pets Helping People annual event and the Job One recycling center.

Charlie has been a school crossing guard for the Grandview School District since 2003 and, most recently, became a 2017 Citizens Academy graduate. He is also a member of the Grandview Memorial VFW Post 8100.

The list goes on and on of his accomplishments. And to top it all off, Charlie is a life member of our Chapter.
